Case studies

Female; two children under 5.

Age: 25

Before meeting the Employment Team this lady had been out of work for four years due to having her children. She had only 9 months experience on her CV working within a hotel catering environment.

The team helped her develop her CV, confidence and negotiated with the DWP about her childcare arrangements so she could attend a twelve week course to achieve a food hygiene certificate. She is thoroughly enjoying it so far.

The Team helped her apply for jobs and explore different sectors. The Team have recommended her for a placement with a guaranteed job at the end of it.

Female; living with her partner and child.

Age: 34

Before meeting the Employment Team this lady had been suffering from agoraphobia for almost twenty years and never worked anywhere for longer than a month.

The Team helped develop her CV, confidence and understanding of job markets and what role she could do. She has since completed IT courses and several interviews with out support. She has also secured a voluntary placement in the mental health sector.
